President's Column

We knew this was going to be an exciting election season. However, no one anticipated the turn of events that landed the Loudoun County League of Women Voters in the news.

The good news is that our five candidate fora received extensive news coverage, not just from the local press but from *The Washington Post*.

The bad news is that our President, Betsy Mayr, resigned. I always appreciated Betsy's dedication to the League, but I had no idea how much time and effort she devoted to League until I had to very quickly step into her shoes.

The interesting news is that the Republicans and Democrats wanted us to hold a candidate forum for each House and Senate race. There are two Senate races - the 27th and 33rd - and five House races - 13th, 32nd, 33rd, 67th, and 86th. There are nine Board of Supervisors districts, nine School Board seats, and six others, including Sheriff, Water Conservation Board, and Clerk of the Circuit Court. That's 31 different races with more than 60 candidates.

In August, the Board met to decide which fora we should hold. We took several factors into consideration, but at the end of the day, we knew we could hold only five fora given our tight budget and lack of active members. Denise Donnelly, Voter Services, did a heroic job of coordinating the fora. She was assisted by three timekeepers, two or three greeters, and the President. While we are blessed with an active Board of Directors, there are only 11 of us. I hope, by keeping the membership more informed of League activities and opportunities, that more members will become involved.

We have plenty of ideas and ambition, but not enough time, money, and volunteers. If you want to get involved, please take a moment to get in touch with me with your suggestions.
