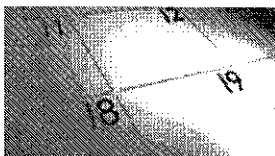

VA Civil Rights Restoration Guide

The LWV of Loudoun County has mailed copies of the [Virginia Civil Rights Restoration Guide](#) to the Loudoun Republican Party and Loudoun Democrats, Sheriff Chapman, Loudoun Aftercare, and the Loudoun County jail. The booklet helps convicted felons restore their voting and other rights, including right to run for public office, serve on a jury, and serve as a notary public. The booklet contains step-by-step instructions on how to determine eligibility and how to apply directly to the Governor for restoration or to petition the court. Also included are application forms, criminal code reference tables, public notary information, and instructions on obtaining or correcting identification. The booklet was published by the [Advancement Project](#), Washington DC. Virginia is one of four states whose laws strip individuals' civil rights upon felony

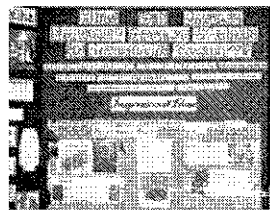

The Nominating Committee has announced the following positions open on the LWV of Loudoun County Board of Directors:

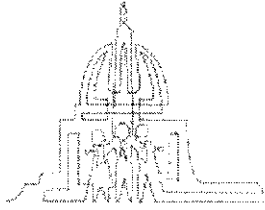
- First Vice President
