This is a fundraising event for the Turning Point Suffragist Memorial Association, which is planning a memorial at Occoquan Regional Park in Lorton, VA to pay tribute to the women who endured harsh imprisonment to secure voting rights for women.

Historian Ann Gordon will be honored with the Silent Sentinel Award for her work compiling 14,000 documents and editing the Elizabeth Cady Stanton and Susan B. Anthony papers. Ken Burns used much of her material in his PBS documentary, "Not or Ourselves Alone: The Story of Elizabeth Cady Stanton & Susan B. Anthony."
